Numbers 13:30-14:12



**CELEBRATION** - How did we seek God's face through prayer and see his hand at work this week?



**WORD** - WHAT DID GOD SAY IN HIS WORD?

**Read together:** Numbers 13:30-14:12

**Recall from Sunday:**

Sons and daughters focus on God's promises instead of our problems, on the issues instead of blaming others, and delight in God rather than despise Him.

**Reflect:** When was the last time God called you to do something that was bigger than your resources? Something that was beyond your ability to plan for all the problems? Did you step forward into it anyway? Did you hold back? Why or why not?



**HEART** - WHAT DID GOD SAY TO ME THROUGH HIS WORD?

The faithless spies took in data about the strength of the inhabitants of the land, but failed to account for the strength of their God who would go with them (Num. 13:31-33). How often does the presence of God with you impact your decisions about your future? Do you feel like you can count on God to be there for you when it counts? Why or why not?

Do you relate to God more as his servant or as his son/daughter? What's the difference? If God has called you his child, how ought that impact the way you approach challenging situations and uncertain futures?



**WORLD** - WHAT DOES GOD WANT ME TO DO ABOUT IT?

Identify where you are focusing on problems and blaming others. Encourage each other to step forward in courage as you reflect on the promises of God together.

Identify what attitudes you are harboring that treat God as small and distant. Confess those attitudes to God and invite him to show you how trustworthy and present he is.
